Overview: Ave Maria School of Law has an opening in the Legal Analysis, Writing, and Research (LAWR) program starting in August 2026.

LAWR is a three-semester course taught in the first and second year of law school for which students earn a total of 7 graded credit hours. The vacancy is for the first-year course, consisting of predictive writing in the Fall and persuasive writing in the Spring.

The vacancy is for a one-year contract but has the potential for additional longer-contracts.

Compensation: Compensation includes an outstanding benefit package and a salary of \$62,000-\$64,000 based on experience and education.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- The individual hired will teach two sections of LAWR I in the Fall semester and LAWR II in the Spring semester, to a total number of 30-40 students.
- Additional duties and responsibilities include:
 - Working in a collaborative team atmosphere, following a common syllabus, texts, and assignments
 - Assisting in creating exercises, handouts, and memo and appellate assignments
 - Meeting regularly with students
 - Attending department and faculty meetings
 - Serving on faculty committees, as assigned by the Dean
 - Other duties that may be assigned to meet institutional needs.

- J.D. from an ABA-accredited law school
- A minimum of three years of legal practice experience
- Excellent academic performance
- Relevant teaching experience, particularly in a legal writing course, preferred
- Knowledge of MS Word, Excel, and PowerPoint
